Barking & Dagenham Post Cup Group Stage Rules

1. The teachers of the home team should arrange the match, pitch and referee.
2. A size 4 football should be used.
3. Each half to be thirty minutes long.
4. As the first round is played on a mini-league basis, extra time and penalties should not be played.
5. Group standings will be decided as follows: 1) Points 2) Result between the two teams. If the teams are still tied, the position shall be shared.
6. All F.A. laws apply, including CRB/Safeguarding requirements.
7. Unlimited substitutes permitted. Rolling subs to be allowed.

8. Only Year Six pupils (boys and girls) may play in the 9-a-side competitions. Teams using ineligible players will be disqualified.

It is expected in Schools' Football that all involved maintain high standards regarding fair play and sportsmanship. Please ensure that the codes of conduct for players and spectators are strictly maintained. In this way we can maintain the good reputation of Barking and Dagenham schools.
